

Reversible Lace Neck Wrap

Yarn: Plymouth Baby Alpaca Grande Tweed – 1 skein

Needles: Sizes 13 & 11

Gauge: in pattern, 10 x 24 stitches, per 4 inch square, before blocking.

Finished size: Approximately 8” by 24”

Notions: Tapestry needle,

Six 1 inch shanked buttons and 3 jump rings,
Needle nosed pliers



Pattern

Using size 13 needles, cast on 67 stitches using long tail method.

Knit three rows in seed stitch (*K1, P1* K1) and continue side borders of three stitches in seed stitch throughout.

Knit from size 13 needles onto size 11 and continue with size 11 through lace rows.

Lace pattern rows (with K, P, K, on each edge):

Row 4: *K2tog, YO*, knit 4th to last stitch together with 3rd to last to make 66 stitches.

Row 5: *P*

Row 6: *YO, K2tog*

Row 7: *P*

Row 8: *P*

Row 9: *K*

Row 10: *YO, Slip 1, K1, pssso*

Row 11: *P*

Row 12: *Slip 1, K1, pssso, YO*

Row 13: *P*

Row 14: *P*

Row 15: *K*



Row 16 to 27, repeat Rows 4 through 15.

Row 28 to 36, repeat Rows 4 through 12.

Knit from size 11 needles onto size 13 and finish scarf on 13's.

Row 37: K, P, increase 1 by K in back- P in front of stitch, *K, P*, K – 67 stitches,

Row 38 and 39: seed stitch

Bind off loosely. If you tend to bind off tightly, you can move up to a size 15 needle or use an extended bind off. Weave in ends.

Block to open up lace pattern. The top and bottom of neck wrap will tend to curve in a bit. If you don't like this, correct in blocking process.

Fasten the six buttons in pairs using the pliers and jump rings. Wrap can be buttoned into multiple configurations using one to three pairs of buttons.
